NEWS FROM THE GARDEN

Spring has sprung and it's time for planting the garden! It's not too late to try starting some of your own plants to give them a head start when you plant them outdoors. An easy way to do this is to recycle a toilet paper tube. Simply cut the tube in half and cut four slits in one end. Fold them in so that it forms a cup. Fill the tube with moistened seed starting soil. Make a small hole with a pencil and add a seed. Good options for seeds would be tomatoes, peppers and watermelons. Keep in a warm spot and moistened until seed sprouts and then just plant in the ground!
