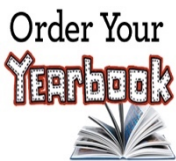

NEWS FROM THE GARDEN

Seeds aren't just for birds! People eat them too, every day. Beans, corn, peas, wheat, are all examples of seeds. Try this easy recipe out for a tasty snack!

Sunflower Seed Balls

Ingredients

Makes about 20 servings

- ½ cup oatmeal
- 2 Tablespoons chia seeds (substitute sesame or flax seeds)
- ½ cup sunflower seeds (substitute chia or sesame seeds)
- ½ cup sunflower butter (substitute peanut or almond butter)
- 2 Tablespoons honey
- Extra chia, sesame or flax seeds to coat outside with (optional) 2 Tablespoons cacao powder

Directions

1. Add the oatmeal, chia seeds, sunflower butter, honey, and cacao powder, to a medium sized mixing bowl
2. Mash and mix all the ingredients together
3. Take a small piece of the mixture and roll in your hands to make a small ball.
4. Continue making small balls until all the mixture is used up.
5. Roll the small balls in extra chia and/or flax seeds to coat the outside.
6. Enjoy!
